



Signature Sunroof in “Tribute to Carroll Shelby” Mustang

WCF selected Signature to install a Signature 755 sunroof into a one-of-a-kind 2013 Shelby Mustang GT500 designed to mirror the look of an identical fully restored and documented 1968 Shelby Mustang GT500. The 1968 vehicle is a Ford Motor vehicle retained to test the viability of installing a sunroof option. Due to its high cost at the time, Ford never offered the sunroof option to the public, and this is the only 1968 Shelby Mustang GT500 known to have had one installed under Ford’s ownership; it is truly a one-of-a-kind vehicle! Signature Automotive has designed the 755 series sunroof specifically for vehicles with sloped and short roof lines. Signature’ sunroof for the 2013 Mustang includes uniquely shaped side rails and glass travel positioning plus OE mechanisms and other features.

The 2013 Shelby Mustang GT500 is finished in candy apple red with white LeMans striping to mirror the look of its 1968 “Twin.” **The 2013 vehicle includes a unique saddle interior designed by Roadwire Leather and made in California by Distinctive Industries. The seats were installed by Classic Soft Trim. Roadwire, DI and CST are affiliates of Signature.**
